Back to Archery Guidelines

Please follow the Club's requests to keep the sport safe during the emergency
(We will update and circulate when necessary)

- Please **STAY AWAY** from the field if you are unwell.
- Please practice **Social Distancing** at all times.
- **Only 1 archer or household to a target.**
- **Targets must be at least 5m apart (marks are provided on metric distance lines).**
Use gloves if you need move targets.
- **Always pre-book your visits to the club.** WAC have a SignUpGenius page to book shooting sessions which you must use prior to your visit. 1 archer or household per target. The sessions are 2 hours long throughout the day and initially allow for 5 targets at one time. Do not go to the field if all lanes are booked.

- **Bring your own Faces and Pins.** Initially Faces and pins will be provided in the unlocked storage. Please take a face and a packet of pins away with you to use in future. The containers will be inaccessible for the time being.
DO NOT put any faces or pins back in the storage.
- **Toilets** will be available as usual, but only one lady or gent in at a time and PLEASE wash your hands BEFORE and AFTER using the facilities.
- **Please take your own hand sanitiser, wipes and disposable gloves** with you to the field. Remember many people walk/cycle through the field, opening and closing the gates, or sitting on the benches.
- **Take ALL rubbish home** with you. No dustbins will be available.
- **Kitchen facilities are unavailable** so please take all refreshments with you.
- **Shoot your distance.** Don't shoot further than you know you can reach as metal detectors will not be available. If you have your own, please remember to bring it along.
- **Bring your own seat,** plastic chairs will not be available.
